Breakout Room Exercise

Scenario:

Your simulation center has received a request from your State's Health Department to help them with a training on Nasopharyngeal Swab Specimen Collection for both rural and urban healthcare providers. Your leadership team wants you to come up with a quick solution to help.

Problem Statement:

A considerable number of frontline healthcare providers are not feeling comfortable with their skills to collect Nasopharyngeal Swab Specimen. They want a skills refresh for the same. Social distancing and travel restrictions are in place, so in-person training at the simulation center is not possible.

Instructions:

Use the *identified problem statement* and develop a curriculum plan for a JITOT Session that addresses this problem: (some of the deliverables are provided to save time)

- 2) *Goal(s) and Objectives*, you can choose between learning or program goals and objectives (Feel free to use the example provided or write your own)

Example:

Goal: The learners will revise their procedural knowledge for nasopharyngeal swab specimen collection

Learning Objective 1: Participants will identify the correct head position for nasal swab insertion by the end of this one-hour JITOT session.
